

- The entry (maximum # of entries: two per person) must be accompanied by the entry form listing your name, contact information, and description
- The entry must be the original work of the submitting individual
- The entry must include a caption under 150 words describing your work (caption optional for forms of literature or film)

Visual Art

Visual Art entries must be **no smaller** than 8 x10 inches in size

Photography

Photography entries must be framed in black and ready to hang. Matting is optional. The entire photograph including matting and frame must be **no smaller** than 8 x10 inches in size.

Literature

Literature (poems, essays, etc.) entries may not exceed 1,000 words in length. Please place 2 copies of your entry into a folder—do not staple papers.

Film

Film entries may not exceed 4 minutes and must be in .wmv format and copied onto a CD.

Judges will not judge on the individual perspectives of diversity, but rather on how well you *express* the topic of diversity. Winners and selected entries will be featured in the Celebrating Divercity, Arcadia: Expressions of Diversity exhibit. The Ruth and Charles Gilb Arcadia Historical Museum reserves the right to disqualify entries deemed inappropriate or entries submitted not according to entry guidelines.

D A T E S

Deadline to submit contest entries: February 27, 2010

Entries must be physically brought into the Museum during open hours (10 a.m. – 4 p.m.) with a completed entry form. Participants will be notified whether or not their entries have made the final round by March 16, 2010

Pick-up for Entries not in Final Round: March 16-20, 2010 – during open hours

Entries that have not made the final round and are not picked up between March 16-20 will automatically become property of the Ruth & Charles Gilb Arcadia Historical Museum.

Opening Reception: March 27, 2010 10 a.m.

Exhibition Close: May 8, 2010

Pick-up for Exhibited Entries: May 11-15, 2010 – during open hours

Exhibited entries not picked up between May 11-15 will automatically become property of the Ruth & Charles Gilb Arcadia Historical Museum.
